



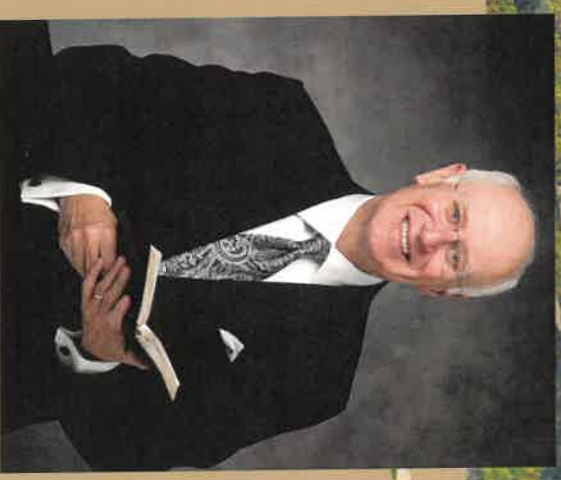
Dr. Wayman Ming Jr.

As a follower of Christ, Dr. Wayman Ming Jr. has traveled to over forty nations proclaiming "Bible truth in Pentecostal power." With a passionate plea for "One Mission - One Movement," Dr. Ming believes that "missioning a global church with a global mission" remains a biblical mandate for the body of Christ. His resume of ministry includes serving lead pastor of Joplin Family Worship Center in Joplin, Missouri and as executive pastor of Higher Vision Church in Valencia, California. He is the founder and president of EXCEED International, and before assuming his current role as General Bishop of the Pentecostal Church of God (PCG), he previously served as Southern Missouri District Bishop, Assistant General Bishop of the North Central Division, and General Secretary. He completed his Doctorate of Ministry from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary.

Wayman and his wife Kimberly have three children, two of which are serving at the International Mission Center of the PCG while their youngest prepares for college as an upperclassman in high school.

Dr. A.D. Beacham, Jr. (Doug) is currently the Chairman and Presiding Bishop of the International Pentecostal Holiness Church (IPHC Ministries). He served as Executive Director of IPHC World Missions Ministries from 2005-2012. A former college teacher, pastor, Georgia Conference Superintendent, and Director of IPHC Church Education Ministries, Beacham has written numerous articles and several books, including Azusa East: The Life and Times of G.B. Cashwell (LSR), Rediscovering the Roles of Apostles and Prophets (LSR), and Plugged In To God's Power (CharismaLife). His most current title is Remembering for the Future, published in 2021.

Beacham is married to the former Susan Reed and they have two children and two granddaughters, Caroline and Lib. He is a graduate of Emmanuel College (A.A.), the University of Georgia (B.A.), and Union Theological Seminary in Virginia (M.Div., Th.M., D.Min.). He currently resides in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, USA.
